	POINT #1: MOTIVATION MATTERS	
	Pray for the sake of prayer, don't pray for the sake of	
	being associated with prayer.	
	POINT #2: PRAY ON PURPOSE	
	Mindlessly rambling the same things over and over	
	disconnects your mind and heart from the words.	
	POINT #3: THERE IS A STRUCTURE TO PRAYER	
	Jesus said to pray in this <i>manner</i> .
